Your task is to investigate skin analysis. 1. What does the beauty therapist use to cover the client's eyes during the skin analysis?
2. What is the piece of equipment called that is used during the skin analysis?
3. What must the beauty therapist remove before completing the skin analysis?
4. Give an example of a skin condition that a beauty therapist would be looking for during the skin analysis.
5. If your client turned red easily from touch do you think they may have a sensitive skin?
6. What cleanser do you think a beauty therapist should always use on the first cleanse?

Look at the list below and decide which you think are the reasons why a skin analysis is carried out. Create a document with your answers. Use the title 'Why Skin Analysis is Important'.
