The aim of The Medical Tuition Service is to
reintegrate pupils back into mainstream
education, at the earliest opportunity

ABOUT MEDICAL TUITION...

Children and young people who are unable to return to school following discharge from hospital or because a medical condition prevents them attending their own school, are sometimes referred to our service. Their consultant will make the referral and advise if tuition should be at our Castle Education Centre, at home, in hospital or elsewhere.

The medical staff will initially contact your child's school and the school staff will make the formal request for medical tuition via the Secondary Placement Panel form.

Following a request for tuition, a tutor will contact you and you will be invited to the Castle Education Centre in order to discuss tuition in more detail.

What We Do:

- Allocate a teacher and/or arrange on-line learning (subject to availability), or arrange for tuition within the hospital or home.
- Arrange times with you for the education sessions. The times can vary but will be within school hours and during term time.
- Contact the referring school of the child/young person, in order to gather information, to enable us to offer the same curriculum as the child's own school.
- Liase with the medical professionals so we can be flexible and sensitive to the needs of the child/young person.

- Set targets to monitor progress and enhance achievement.
- Send a report to your child's school each term.
- Work with other services including the Education Welfare Service and medical professionals to ensure good attendance while on tuition.
- Support the child in reintegration back into their school.

We Need You To:

- Encourage and support your child's attendance at all tuition sessions.
- Ensure that your child is ready at the arranged times.
- For tuition at home, ensure a responsible adult is present in the home at tuition times.
- Provide a suitable workplace; quiet, safe, smoke free with a table and chairs, and any pets kept in a separate area.
- Let us know as early as possible if you need to cancel a teaching session for a valid reason.
- Inform us if your child or another family member is ill or has an infection.
- Attend and contribute to reviews for your child.
- Support and encourage your child with any independent learning.
